I hope that your travel and activities over the summer have given you an opportunity to rest and spend time together as a family. Our school districts are preparing for the coming school year, and we at Faith are following with our own upcoming year of learning. I invite you to attend a **parents' meeting on Wednesday, August 24 at 6:00PM**. Students may attend with their parents. You will have an opportunity to meet your student's teacher and address any potential concerns that you have for your student. For students in 8th grade, we will also cover confirmation.

For students entering 6th through 8th grade, you will have the opportunity to serve as acolytes during the year. Students are assigned to Sunday and Wednesday night services (schedule is enclosed). These students have a willingness and enthusiasm to serve and I thank them in advance for giving their time to assist in worship.

One final invitation is for our **LYF youth group for students in 8th grade through high school**. We meet on **Wednesday nights at 8:00PM**. After a game or activity, we spend time hearing about God's promises and love for us. This time allows students to build friendships with other Christians who will be able to support them during the struggles of life.
