



Record-setting food drive in 2022!

Faith Lutheran's congregation answered the call to action once again this year, and donated a record amount of food and household products for the Pierre-Ft. Pierre Food Pantry in March!

The congregation donated **3,572 items**, far surpassing our previous high of 2,350 items donated following the Missouri River flood of 2011. A great crew of volunteers loaded up and delivered the **181 boxes** to the Food Pantry on April 8th. The donations weighed in at a record **2,429.40 pounds** (50 pounds more than our previous record, set in 2017). In addition, members of the congregation gave **financial contributions totaling \$1,541**, **plus \$10 in Beef Bucks**.

Pierre Area Referral Service (PARS), which runs the Food Pantry, had said they were in particular need of diapers, spaghetti sauce, ketchup and mustard, macaroni and cheese, paper towels and toilet paper – and Faith's congregation really delivered!

Among items collected this year:

1,309 diapers

292 packages/containers of soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrushes, personal care products (a record!)

289 boxes of macaroni and cheese (our highest ever!)

235 cans of fruits and vegetables

159 cans of tuna, chicken and other canned meat

153 cans and packages of soup, stew, chili and ramen noodles

119 boxes and bags of dry pasta

115 cans of spaghetti sauce (a new record)

79 bottles and packages of household products: cleaners, dish soap, trash

bags, paper towels, toilet paper

- 76 bottles of ketchup and mustard (highest ever)
- 74 pasta meals in cans
- 67 boxes and bags of cereal
- 55 packages of cake mix (most we've ever donated)
- 52 cans and bags of beans
- 52 boxes of "helper" meals for hamburger, tuna and chicken
- 40 bottles of peanut butter and jelly
- 38 bags of flour and sugar
- 31 boxes of pancake mix

25 bottles of syrup
